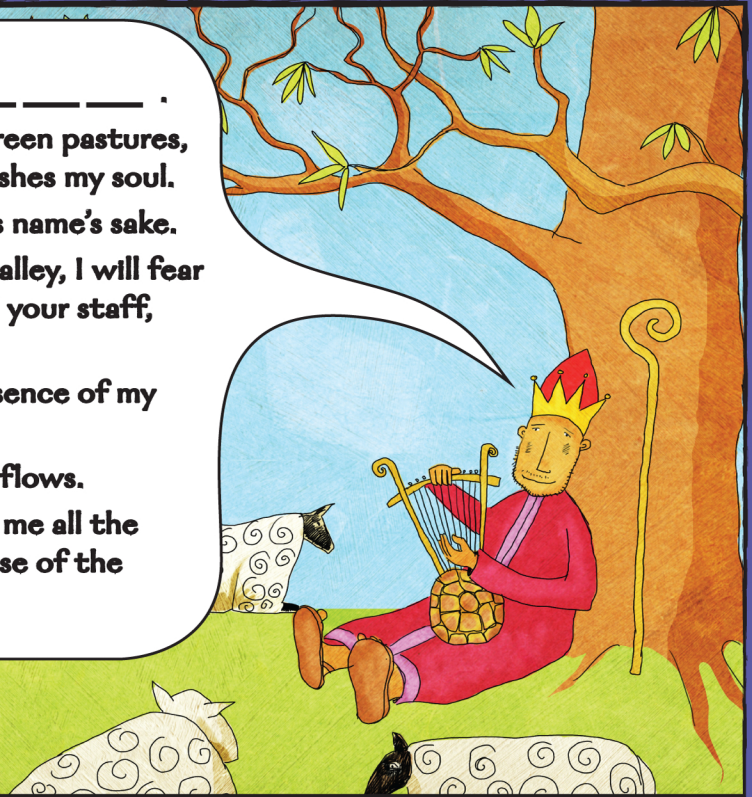


The LORD is my _____ .
