We are so proud of you for wanting to deepen your prayer life. Because of Jesus, you can pray anytime, anyplace, about anything directly to God. Prayer connects us to لesus. Jesus understands what it's like to live on our earth, to feel our hurts, and to be tempted like us. He understands because He experienced life in a human body. so He knows what you are going through.

If you're not sure where to begin, then this book will be a great start for you. Sit down and go through this book with your parents or an adult that is important in your life. That adult might help you read a little bit or explain how you can use some of the prayers. Please ask them questions if you're not sure of something. Beside most of the prayers is a biblical scripture of God's promise of that prayer.

Praying is like any activity. The more you do it, the easier it will become. Then the more you'll want to do it as you experience the presence of Jesus. Your real conversations with Jesus can change your life in the best way possible.

Use the ideas and prayers in here to create a habit of prayer. The goal is to pray for 21 days during the month, or even better, 21 days in a row. On the back page of the book you'll find ZI boxes for you to check off, write the date, or draw a simple picture for what you prayed during the month as you spend time working through this book or in prayer. Bring it back to RBFK for a certificate of completion. We'll give it to you the following week as we proudly announce your name in class (unless you ask us not to).

## Prayer is simply talking to God anytime, anyplace, about anything.

The hardest part about prayer is making it a habit. Scientist say that most people need to repeat something 21 times for it to become a habit. That's our goal with this prayer book.

On the back page of the book you'll find 21 baxes for you to check off. write the date, or draw a simple picture for what you prayed during the month as you spend time working through this book or in prayer. Bring it back to RBFK for a certificate of completion.

Work through the following ideas because you must have a plan to determine your time and place. What you talk about in prayer will depend on your needs for that day.

## My times to pray

(test out 3, then you decide which was best after 21 days)

You'll do best if you connect it to some other event that you already do. That will be your "trigger" to pray. For example: after brushing your teeth, after snack when you get hame from schoal, right before bed, etc.

Anather tip is to pick an abject you always see, like a clack. Each time you look at any clock, say a quick thank-you to God for something that He's blessed you with.

Thank you for loving me so much. Thank you for wanting me to be with you farever. I'm sarry that I have disobeyed and sinned against you. Thank you for taking my punishment for my disobeying. Please forgive me for what I have done wrong. I want You Jesus, to be my Savior, Forgiver, and my Forever Friend. I want to love You all the days of my life. Please help me to listen to You and obey You. I love you, Jesus. Amen

## The Lord's Prayer

Jesus was talking with his disciples and they asked Him to teach them to pray. Jesus modeled this prayer that we call "The Lard's Prayer". Jesus told the disciples not to pray just these words, but to use their own words with these ideas.
> "Dur Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen" (Matthew 6:1-13 NKJV)

## The Armor of God

This passage from the Bible is one of the most memorable and one of the best ways to face your day. Consider using the prayer before you start your day.

Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armar of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. Therefore, put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the world of God. And pray in the Spirit on all accasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's peaple. (Ephesians E:II-18 NIV)

## Protection Through the Armar of Gad

Dear Heavenly Father, I ask far Your protection today with Your armor. I put on the belt of truth to speak and act in honest ways. With the breastplate of righteousness. I will choose to do what is right, even if it's hard. I will be prepared to use the gospel of peace to solve my problems.
