Miriam served God by doing a small job with great value. She had a big responsibility to take care of her baby brother, Moses. Miriam's task was to make sure baby Moses floated down the Nile River in his basket safely. During this time, the Egyptian rulers didn't want any Jewish families to have newborn sons. Sending baby Moses down the river was the only way to keep him out of harms way. Even though Miriam was small and young, her service of protecting her brother was very important. An Egyptian princess found baby Moses at the end of the river and wanted to keep him as her own. Miriam continued to serve by making sure the princess had a nurse to help her with the baby. This nurse was Moses' real mother. Miriam's purpose was simple: to serve by being responsible for her brother's safety. Even serving on a small scale can lead to great outcomes! (Source: Exodus 2)
